Ms. Varón, born and raised in Peru is a watercolor and pastel painter. She paints full time in her studio in Wickford Rhode Island.

As a child in Lima, Patricia demonstrated a natural ability with watercolors, a medium she loves because of its natural fluidity and portability. She was first exposed to this medium as a child by her British art teacher. In spite of no encouragement to pursue painting professionally, she studied drawing and painting with local well known artist, Elena Vaccari. She later attended college in the United States in order to pursue a degree in Art, continuing her education at the School of the Museum of Art in Boston where she pursued watercolor studies under Kaji Aso and more recently under Bill Commerfold. At the New England School of Art and Design at Suffolk University she earned a degree in Space Planning and Design. She practiced Interior Design for over 20 years and owned her own design studio in Massachusetts. In the last two years that Ms. Varón has devoted herself to painting full-time.

Ms. Varón has painted internationally in Peru, Nicaragua, and Guatemala where she lived and in Italy and Turkey and lately in Taos, New Mexico under Kevin Macpherson and locally under Anthony Tomaselli, Margie Ball and Jean Tangney.

Ms. Varón has shown accepted work in the 2016 New England Watercolor Society's North American Open Watercolor Show in Gloucester, Massachusetts. She also has shown her work at the Needham Art Association Gallery in Needham, MA and locally at the Spring Bull Gallery in Newport, RI, the DeBlois Gallery in Middletown, RI and the Wickford Art Association Gallery, in Wickford, RI. She is the Juried Member of the month at the Wickford Art Association and one of the featured artists in the Juried Artist Member Invitation at the Wickford Art Association from July 28th to August 20.
