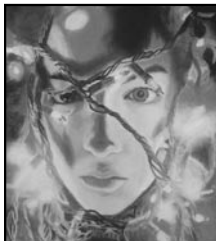

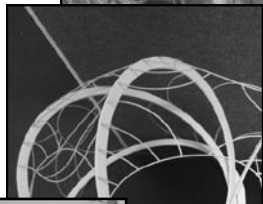

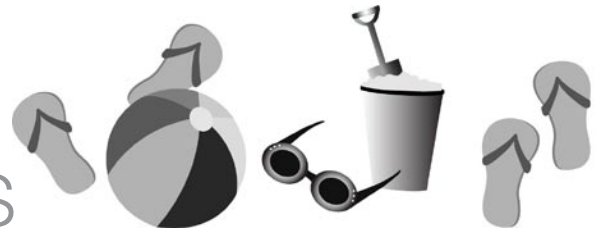

Bonnie Jaffe's photography "Floral Impressions" was accepted in to the 102nd Exhibition of the Connecticut Academy of Fine Arts at the Mystic Art Center, "New York Moment" won First Prize at the DeBlois Gallery *Seven Deadly Sins* Exhibit in March and "The Salesman" was accepted in to the Newport Art Museum Annual Members' Show in February.

Eileen McCarney Muldoon has been accepted to Photography Now! Juror Karin Rosenthal viewed nearly 500 images in the process of selecting the 69 pieces for the "South Shore Art Center" show.

Marian L. O'Connell had three miniature prints accepted into the Center for Contemporary Printmaker's 9th International Miniature Print Biennial. Juror Jan Howard reviewed 816 prints from 37 countries and 27 states. Each print could be no larger than 4 square inches. The exhibition dates are June 2 to September 1, 2013 at the Center of Contemporary Printmaking, Mathews Park, 299 West Avenue, Norwalk, CT.
