Materials Fee: \$30

Materials student will need to provide:

Source images: Bring printed photos or magazine pictures that inspire you to create abstract or semi-abstract paintings.

Paint: Bring any brand of watercolor in tubes (or liquid watercolor in bottles) in primary colors, red, yellow and blue. Feel free to bring other colors as well.

Brushes: I prefer to use a large brush. If you don't have large brushes, don't buy an expensive brush. You can pick up an inexpensive synthetic brush in size 12 or 16-inch round and/ or 1 and 1.5 flat. Feel free to bring other size brushes you may have.

Buy at least three pieces of foam board or cardboard of roughly 20 x30 inches in size to do a cobweb technique and to transport wet paintings home.

Water container, Plastic wrap, Wax paper, Scissors, Plastic plates, Masking tape, Tissues

Paper Towels (Viva brand doesn't leave imprint)

Any type of salt: table, kosher

Spray bottle for water - any size

If you have water-soluble crayons, colored pencils, Inktense blocks or pencils, or other media to work into your pieces, feel free to bring them in. (see below)

Notebook and pen or pencil to take notes

Optional: Stamps or any other type of mark making tool.

Optional: Hair dryer

Materials provided by instructors

Terra Skin, Yupo, cobwebbing material, Tar Gel

Bottles of pre-mixed paint

Pipettes

Pushpins

Assorted mark making items

Water soluble crayons, colored pencils, Inktense blocks, etc. and other media to work into your pieces
