CALL FOR ENTRY:

Members Only - *Spring Salon*

We are now accepting up to 60 artists' work for this unique exhibit. Register now!

- **One piece** is allowed **per registered artist**.
- Artists who submit to this salon must be active General Artist or Juried Artist Members.
- Registration fee: **\$20.00 (one item only)**
- 2 dimensional art pieces in this particular exhibit **must be no larger than 24"** (including frame) on the longest side.
- All work must be properly prepared for presentation. This includes **proper wiring** and in a state ready to sell. (No sawtooth hangers are permitted).
- Art work submissions drop off: Tuesday, May 10 (12- 6pm) & Wednesday, May 11 (12-3pm)
- Exhibit Runs: **May 13 - May 29, 2022.**
- Post exhibit - Artwork collection: Tuesday, May 31 (12 - 6pm).

Please read below for other important information:

ARTWORK INFORMATION:

Artwork must be current fine art (less than 3 years old). Work must be original creations by the artist and not created under a teacher's instruction. Any photography that references or excerpts work from another must be referenced in the title. Crafts, diptychs, triptychs, etc are not accepted. Fine art is accepted in a variety of mediums based on the specific requirements.

Functional fine art is accepted on a limited basis and will be curated as such by the Gallery Director.

WAA registration staff are not responsible for cleaning, wiring or touching up your artwork. The artist is responsible for proper wiring and in a state ready to sell. Acceptance into the exhibit is subject to a condition inspection and approval by the Gallery Director. Gallery wrapped canvas or standout mounts, should be at least 1-1.5 inches deep with finished sides and no visible staples. Photographs printed on metal, acrylic and/or wood can be accepted if the presentation has integrated hangers and attached wires. **No sawtooth hangers are permitted.** Sculptures must be easy to move for one person.

WAA collects a commission on works sold. **30% for all members.** Commissions are paid quarterly. WAA is not liable for lost or damaged work and recommends artists have their work insured. WAA reserves the right to refuse entry to works that do not fit its community standards. ALL ART MUST BE FOR SALE. "NOT FOR SALE" or PRICE ON REQUEST" are conditions that are not allowed. Please label your artwork with your name, price and contact information before registration.

Work must be collected by the deadline specified on page one of these terms. WAA has limited storage space and works left behind risk being damaged. A \$5 fee will be required for art left in the gallery past the specified deadline unless prior arrangements have been made with the gallery staff.

#### FINE FUNCTIONAL ART:

A limited number of fine functional art works may be accepted in the following categories - and will be accepted only as space allows:

- Ceramics (pieces made by shaping and firing of clay)
  - Exhibition of ceramic works will require coordination between artist and gallery staff to ensure the safety of displayed work as the gallery is a multi-function space hosting exhibits, classes and workshops.
- Fiber and Paper Arts (works made of fiber and/or handmade paper- wearable, hangable, or otherwise usable).

- Exhibition of any fiber or paper work accepted will require coordination between artist and gallery staff for proper display.
- Jewelry (produced from metal, glass, clay, fiber, paper, plastic or other materials)
  - Exhibition of any jewelry accepted will require coordination between artist and gallery staff for proper display and security.
- Furniture or Wooden Works (hand-tooled or machine-works - turned or carved)
  - Due to space limitations furniture is only accepted if space allows.
