Thank you for reviewing the following requirements BEFORE registering your artwork

Do you have a favorite single piece from the last three years that you haven't yet had an opportunity to exhibit? This is your chance! We are now accepting one-piece per member artist. Work for this unique exhibit has a cap of sixty (60) pieces total.

Register now as space is limited! Registration will be open until cap is met.

guidelines

One (1) piece is allowed per registered artist. Artists who submit to this exhibit must be active Members - either General Artist or Juried Artist, with active status when registering and through the duration of the exhibit.

fee

Registration fee: \$20.00 (one item only)

size

2 dimensional art pieces in this particular exhibit must be no larger than 24" (including frame) on the longest side.

presentation

All work must be properly prepared for presentation. All frames must be in excellent condition and mats must be clean and ready for professional presentation in the exhibit. For 2D work this includes **proper wiring to the frame** and in a state ready to sell. (NOTE: No sawtooth hangers are permitted). Please inquire with the gallery if you have any questions about these artwork acceptance parameters. Pieces that do not meet our artwork presentation guidelines will unfortunately not be accepted into the exhibit.

dates

Drop-off: Tue, Jan. 3 (12-6pm) & Wed, Jan. 4 (12-4pm)
Opening reception: Friday, January 6 from 5 to 7PM
Exhibit Dates: January 6 through February 5, 2023.
Artwork pick-up: Tuesday, Feb. 7 (12 - 6pm).s

2023 General Guidelines

Artwork should be current (less than 3 years old).

~~2D work cannot exceed 56 inches in height, 44 inches in width.~~

All 2D art must be properly wired to the frame.

No saw-tooth hangers are permitted.

Functional fine art is accepted on a limited basis and will be juried to the same standards as non-functional art and must reflect the individual themes of the exhibit.

No fine-art reproductions (ex: An original piece of art (pastel, oil, watercolor, acrylic, pencil, charcoal etc) that is reproduced on an ink-jet printer).

No multi-panel pieces (diptychs, triptychs, etc.) will be accepted.

All work must be original and not created under a teacher's supervision.

Artwork shown in one exhibit at the WAA gallery cannot be shown again in a future exhibit at the WAA gallery.

All exhibited work must be for sale.
Registration fees are non-refundable.

WAA collects commissions on all work sold (30% members, 40% non-members).

WAA is not responsible for lost or damaged work; artwork should be insured.

WAA may refuse entry to works that do not fit its community standards.

Entry fees for each exhibit are posted on the calls for entry and the registration forms. Members benefit from discounted rates.
