This is your chance! This call is **open to all artists working in all media** (the original calendar excluded Photography. This was in error)

Work for this unique exhibit will be juried for entry and judged for awards by Rhode Island Fine Artist/Photographer [Ruth Clegg](#).

This call for entry is open through December 27, 2022. Register today!

guidelines

Up to (3) pieces may be submitted per registered artist. This exhibit is open to all artists. Being a member of the Wickford Art Association is not required to be considered.

presentation

All work must be properly prepared for presentation. If artwork is two-dimensional: all frames must be in excellent condition and mats must be clean and ready for professional presentation in the exhibit. For 2D work this includes **proper wiring to the frame** and in a state ready to sell. (NOTE: No sawtooth hangers are permitted). Please inquire with the gallery if you have any questions about these artwork acceptance parameters. Pieces that do not meet our artwork presentation guidelines will unfortunately not be accepted into the exhibit.

dates

Drop-off: Tue, Feb. 7 (12-6pm) & Wed, Feb. 8 (12-4pm)
Opening reception: Friday, February 10th from 5 to 7PM
Exhibit Dates: February 10 through March 12, 2023.
Artwork pick-up: Tuesday, March 14 (12 - 6pm)

2023 General Guidelines

Artwork should be current (less than 3 years old).

2D work cannot exceed 56 inches in height/44 inches in width.

All 2D art must be properly wired to the frame.

No saw-tooth hangers are permitted.

Functional fine art is accepted on a limited basis and will be juried to the same standards as non-functional art and must reflect the individual themes of the exhibit.

No fine-art reproductions (ex: An original piece of art (pastel, oil, watercolor, acrylic, pencil, charcoal etc) that is reproduced on an ink-jet printer).

No multi-panel pieces (diptychs, triptychs, etc.) will be accepted.

All work must be original and not created under a teacher's supervision.

Artwork shown in one exhibit at the WAA gallery cannot be shown again in a future exhibit at the WAA gallery.

All exhibited work must be for sale. Registration fees are non-refundable. (View registration form for fees)

WAA collects commissions on all work sold (30% members, 40% non-members).

WAA is not responsible for lost or damaged work; artwork should be insured.

WAA may refuse entry to works that do not fit its community standards.

Entry fees for each exhibit are posted on the calls for entry and the registration forms. Members benefit from discounted rates.
