Portrait Mode: Drawing and Painting Suggested Materials

Students' choice! You can bring the media and materials you want to use, whether that's paints and canvas and brushes, or a sketchbook and set of pens, or pastels and a few sheets of cold press paper. Don't break the bank on this one. Bring the materials you have at home and are comfortable with, or the ones you've wanted to try! Feel free to reach out to me with any questions ahead of the class.

- a set of paints (watercolor, acrylic, gouache, or oils), and brushes and canvas or watercolor paper OR

- a drawing sketchbook — any medium weight paper will do, but if you have a preference for working with ink, something with thicker pages might be helpful to minimize the bleed through. 11"x14" or so is great, or bigger!

- Pencils and pens and markers, colored pencils, pastels oh my! Examples: roller ball pens, gel pens, markers, graphite, charcoal or nice heavy drafting pencils, erasers etc.
