

## Official Prospectus - Holiday Small Works On view November 10 - December 22, 2023

about

WAA's: Holiday Small Works show is back! Established artists (who are WAA members) in all media are invited to submit work. This exhibit will feature some great pieces!

opening

An opening reception will take place on Friday, November 10 from 5 - 7pm. All accepted artists are invited to attend. Artists are encouraged to invite guests.

rules

Only current members may apply. No giclees (high-quality ink jet prints), or digitally scanned prints. Artwork must be for sale and priced between \$30.00 - \$300.00. If artwork is two-dimensional it must be framed, wired and/or presented according to our exhibit submission guidelines (on wickfordart.org). Where possible, artwork should be signed on the front or verso of the piece. Photographs must be numbered editions at or under 200.

artist duties Artists must provide their own professional title cards (Title of Piece, Artist's name, Medium, and Price). Also, clearly label the back of each artwork with the artist's name and title and price. (See terms on page 2 for more details). A template for title cards is available upon request. Artists hang their own works for the Holiday Small Works

Show on: Tue. 11/7, 12-6pm, Wed. 11/8, 12-6pm, Th. 11/9, 12 - 6pm. Work must be displayed

in a professional manner, representative of the gallery's artistic standards. Please bring one (1) printed copy of your bio and or artist statement for inclusion in the exhibit binder.

definition

WAA's definition of "Small Works" for this exhibit is 2D or 3D original fine art with a maximum of 14" on the longest side (frame included).

application process

A registration fee of \$50.00 must be paid at time of signing up. Participation is open to current WAA artist members and Juried Artist Members. Artists may renew with WAA when registering. To register, please include one (1) to three (3) representative pieces in a low-resolution digital format (.jpeg only) (under 3MB).

when

Registration starts Friday, September 8, 2022 on our website <a href="www.wickfordart.org">www.wickfordart.org</a>. Up to forty-two (41) 2D artists will be accepted and up to to four (4) -3D artists will be accepted. Registration is open until cap is met. This is a very popular show with collectors so we encourage you to register early to save your spot. Exhibit runs from November 10 - December 22, 2022. Art pick up dates following the close are: Wedmesday, December 27, 12 - 4pm and Thursday, December 28, from 12 - 4. Please note these dates in your calendar.

## terms

Artwork from **2D artist** will be limited to the number of pieces allowed in their assigned wall display space based on the following guidelines:

- If using 11" x 14" frames/stretchers, 6 works will be allowed.
- Stretchers must be at least 2" thick to be accepted.
- If using 8"x10" or 9"x12" frames/stretchers, 8 works will be allowed.
- If using frames/stretchers smaller than 8"x10", up to 12 works will be allowed.
- If there is a combination of sizes, decisions on amounts will be made by the gallery staff on the day of drop off.

Amount of art work for **3D artists** will be limited to the use of up to three (3) podiums **each.** WAA reserves the right to limit pieces or remove artwork.

Each artist must complete and submit an INVENTORY FORM listing each artwork by title, medium and price. (Form is below on page 3). Please include your telephone, email and website address). Do **NOT** include replacement inventory on the list at time of drop off.

Artists may not mark or damage the walls or panels. Each artist received approximately a 4' H  $\times$  3-1/2' W section of space to display their artwork. Individual browse bins are not allowed due to space constraints.

Organized displays lead to better sales, we encourage you to plan carefully, frame works in a consistent manner, and group sale pieces by size. Displayed work should be a cohesive group, i.e. same type frame, similar subjects, etc.

Numbers will be assigned to each of the spaces and corresponding numbers will be randomly drawn from a container upon your arrival for hanging. Assignments are on a first-come, first-served basis.

Hanging nails are provided. Helpful hint: bring your own hammer; only a few are available in the gallery.

WAA is not liable for lost or damaged work. WAA recommends all artists insure their work.

As an artist's work sells, the artist will be contacted by phone or email notifying the artist for the option to replace sold pieces with additional pieces.

Artist Payments: Artist Members are paid after the closure of the show for sold work, minus WAA's 30% commission.

Gallery sitting by exhibiting artists is strongly encouraged to help promote sales, extend hours as well as give visitors the opportunity to "meet the artists". WAA staff will train you - it's easy. By participating in Small Works, artists grant WAA permission to use images for social media/web and print promotions. Thank you for your interest in exhibiting with us.
