- The Juror for this exhibit is <u>Richard Whitten</u>. He grew up in Manhattan where he juror earned a B.A. with Honors in Economics from Yale University and an M.F.A. in Painting from the University of California, Davis. He has had numerous solo exhibitions and is in the permanent collection of museums on both coasts. He is currently in a two-person exhibition, A Cabinet of Curious Matters, at the Fenimore Museum in Cooperstown, NY, and he looks forward to an extensive solo exhibition, Set in Motion, at the Morris Museum in Morristown, NJ in 2024. He received a 2023 Pollock Krasner Foundation Grant for his ongoing project, The Museo Galileo Manuscript: Crosscurrents of Chinese and European Scientific Thought. He is presently a Professor of Painting and has completed a term as Art Department Chairperson at Rhode Island College. Following the delivery of accepted works. A live judging will be conducted by the awards juror for prizes. First Place: \$250, Second Place: \$135, Third Place: \$75 and two honorable mentions. opening An opening reception will take place for artists, their guests and the general public on Friday, March 15th, 2024 from 5 - 7pm with awards at 6pm. reception All works must be priced and available for purchase. WAA retains 30% for all sales by member exhibitors, 40% on all sales by non-member exhibitors. and sales Artist commissions are sent within two weeks after sale of an artwork.
