

# **Browse Bin Guidelines**

for Juried Artists Members ONLY

The Browse Bin is another great way to sell your artwork in the gallery. Artists must be a Juried Artist Member and current on dues. Juried Artist Members may display up to 8 pieces of original signed artwork [NOT a Gicleé (reproduction of original art)]. Photographs must be signed and numbered in a series. Please read our guidelines below and contact the gallery with any questions.

# ARTWORK MUST BE INDIVIDUALLY LISTED ON THE BROWSE BIN INVENTORY SHEET AND PLACED IN THE BINDER:

Juried Artist Members may display no more than 8 pieces of work. Please print out, complete and submit the registration sheet with your artwork – during Gallery business hours – so staff can update database.

# EACH PIECE MUST BE PROFESSIONALLY PREPARED:

Original artwork MUST be properly matted, enclosed in a fitted sealed sleeve and MUST include Artist's Name, Title of Artwork, Medium, and PRICE visible on the back (email address - optional). All artwork submitted will be accepted at the discretion of the Gallery Coordinator.

## A PRICE STICKER MUST BE AFFIXED ON THE FRONT OF EACH SLEEVE:

Each sticker will include the FIRST and LAST INITIALS of the ARTIST with the LINE# which corresponds to the inventory line number listed on the inventory sheet – as well as the PRICE. (Example – John Doe's pieces would be labeled JD-1, JD-2, etc. then add the PRICE below – see registration sheet for an example.)

### **INVENTORY:**

Artists are responsible for rotating and replenishing their inventory and updating their inventory sheet 3 times during the year – April 30 / August 31 / December 31.

<u>NOTE:</u> WAA is NOT responsible for lost, damaged or stolen artwork. Artwork left for more than one year will become the property of WAA.

### **PAYMENTS:**

WAA collects a 3% processing fee before calculating the commission on works sold: 20% for JAM members. Commissions are paid out the first of every month.

### **HELPFUL HINTS:**

We recommend that specific locations in the artwork be identified.
