PLEASE photograph artwork straight on – <u>CROP OUT</u> the framing. (See guidelines for photographing artwork)

Submitted JPGs must match the artwork you drop off at the gallery.

Please note: the Installation Committee will hang all artwork for this exhibit.

Size Limitation: There is a limit of four (4) pieces per artist.

2D art pieces in this exhibit must be no smaller than 6" and no larger than 14" on the longest side <u>including frame</u>. 3D art pieces can be no larger than 10x10.

NOTE: WAA reserves the right to limit pieces or remove artwork

All work must be properly prepared for presentation – ALL artwork MUST

be for sale - priced between \$50.00 - \$300.00.

All frames must be in excellent condition, glass and matts must be clean and ready for professional presentation in the exhibit. For 2D work this includes proper wiring to the <u>frame</u> and in a state ready to sell. Please inquire if you have any questions about acceptance parameters.

As an artist's work is sold, it will be listed as "Sold" on the website. The artist can replace the sold item with a similar size piece to fit into the space allocated. It is the artist's responsibility to check the website, they will NOT be notified by email.

Artist Payments – General Artist Members retain 70% of all sales, while Juried Artist Members retain 80%, with a 3% processing fee deducted if a credit card is used for the purchase. Checks will be mailed out monthly
