Real or Imagined.....There is no 'definitive' proof of reality; we rely on our senses and what we know as objective evidence to be 'real'. While our thoughts do not directly create the physical world around us, they do have the power to influence and shape our individual realities. As humans, we are capable of manifesting many things into creation and our perceptions are uniquely our own; particularly artists (of any medium), remain the power-houses behind ferrying the imaginary into states of reality or reversing realities toward the surreal. We want to see works of art that play with the concept of what is real or imagined, and perhaps what lurks in between. The way these 'states' can be conveyed is limitless and might be demonstrated through something as simplistic as the study of a still life, to a complex life event translated into a mysterious riddle.

Guidelines: Up to (3) pieces are allowed per artist. 3D artworks are allowed three (3) image uploads

per piece. When preparing jpegs of your artwork PLEASE photograph artwork straight on PLEASE crop OUT the framing – Juror only needs to see artwork for acceptance. This

shows your work at its best!

Registration Fees: Member fees: 1 piece \$20 | 2 pieces \$30 | 3 pieces \$40

Student Member fees: 1 piece \$10 | 2 pieces \$15 | 3 pieces \$20 Non-Member fees: 1 piece \$25 | 2 pieces \$40 | 3 pieces \$55

Size: 2D art pieces in this exhibit must be no larger than 48"on the longest side including frame.

Presentation: All work must be properly prepared for presentation – **ALL artwork MUST be for sale**. All

frames must be in excellent condition, glass and mats must be clean and ready for professional presentation in the exhibit. For 2D work this includes proper wiring to the frame and in a state ready to sell. Please inquire if you have any questions about

acceptance parameters. Pieces that do not meet our artwork presentation guidelines will

not be accepted into the exhibit.

EMAILS will ONLY be sent to the accepted artists for follow ups and reminders.
